- Students who will be applying to any Washington state accredited community, vocational/technical college, or university
- Students who can demonstrate a need for additional funding to complete their programs in a construction industry-related field of study

### **Application Packet**

Submit the following five items and mail to:

- 1. **Application form**. Fill out completely or mark N/A if not applicable. Incomplete information may affect the rating of your application. All information you provide is strictly confidential.
- 2. Three letters of recommendation describing your qualifications that make you a clear choice for a BIAW scholarship. At least two letters should be from those who interact with you in your professional life: supervisor, co-worker, counselor, teacher, etc.
- 3. **Academic transcript** (unofficial copy allowed) from your last two semesters, three quarters, or a copy of your most recent transcript.
- 4. Essay A 250-word essay (min.) on your career goals.

### **Application Deadline and Notification**

PLEASE NOTE: The deadline to submit an application has been extended until June 19. The selection committee will make its decision in July.

All application packets must be postmarked by May 15, 2020. The selection committee will make its decision in early June. Scholarship award recipients will be contacted via mail by June 30, 2020. All applicants will be mailed notice of their final status.

### **Evaluation Criteria**

Applicants will be judged according to the following criteria:

20% Academic Record

20% Work Experience

15% Community Service/Extracurricular School Activities

15% Recommendation

15% Financial Need

15% Essay
